

## Theme Settings for Virtual Y

There are three supported themes for Virtual Y:

- Carnation
- Lily
- Rose

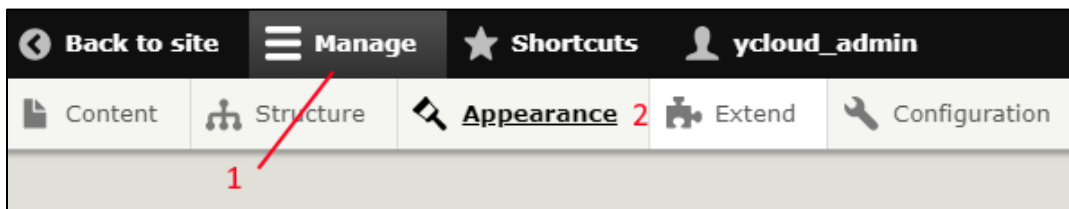
Each theme has different aspects that may be changed within the theme itself. This guide will outline those items.

*Please note, Rose is not included in this guide as no association has chosen this theme for use yet.*

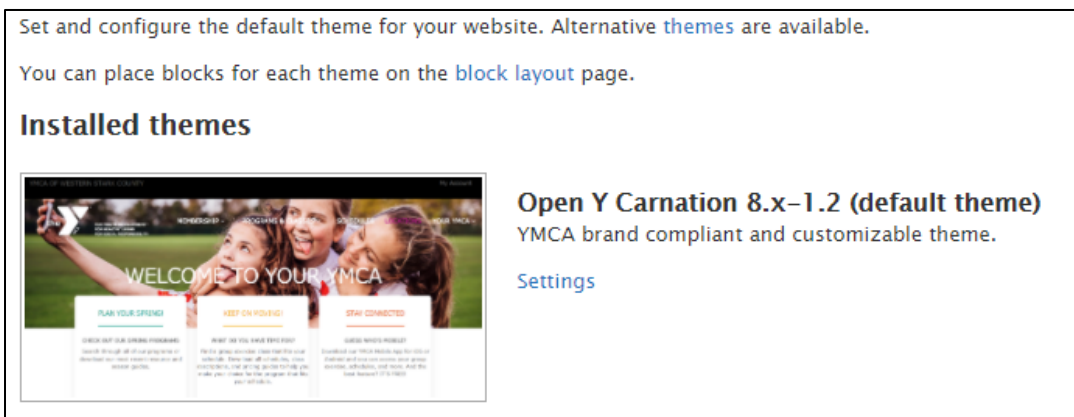
*Also note, it is recommended that if you would like to change your theme to contact the Y Cloud team.*

### Carnation

1. Navigate to the theme page by
  - a. Clicking **Manage**
  - b. Clicking **Appearance**



2. Your installed theme will be listed at the **top**.



3. You may also change settings for the Logo and Favicon

- a. To change the **Logo Image**, **uncheck** the “**use the logo supplied by the theme**” and **upload** your own logo.
- b. To change the **Favicon**, **uncheck** the “**use the favicon supplied by the theme**” and **upload** your own favicon.

7. Within **Lily**, you may alter the color scheme. Do so by
  - a. Ensuring the **lock icon** is **unlocked** next to the element colors you wish to change
  - b. Altering the **hex color code** for the element

  - a. Note, some previews listed are for aspects of full Open Y websites



9. You may also change settings for the Logo and Favicon
